Outstanding Alumni/Community Member Award

Program Description:

The Lincoln High School Preservation Alumni Association incorporated will honor outstanding alumnus in 2018. Recipients of this honor are recognized for their outstanding works or unusual accomplishments in their chosen field of endeavor as an alumnus of this historical institution. This award may also be given to a Sumter community member who has gone above, and beyond their contribution to the establishment of this school. Recipients of the Hall of Fame award are exemplars of exceptional accomplishments and thereby set high standards for all of the descendants of Lincoln High Institution.

Award Procedures:

1. Nominations forms will be accepted by mailing to the address in #5 or completing the form on the website beginning January 1st thru March 31st of each year. To preserve the significance of this award, each recipient must be extremely deserving; therefore, nominees will be considered two consecutive years. If they are not voted upon as a recipient by the end of the second year, their name will be removed from the list for the third year. Such name may be resubmitted the following year.
2. If the recipient is unable to attend the awards program, there must be a designated individual to accept the award and speak on his/her behalf.
3. Number of recipients per year will be limited to seven (7). Nominated candidates who were not selected, rated as numbers 8, 9, and 10, will automatic be recipients the next year along with four (4) additional nominees. Self-nomination will be accepted.
4. Nomination form may be downloaded from the website and printed or typed. Please include a picture of the nominee from his/her high school year book or current picture. (No cursive writing PLEASE)
